SCHOOL REMINDERS

Some of our students and staff have life-threatening allergies to nuts and nut products. Therefore, our school is "NUT-AWARE".

We are asking for your help and cooperation in ensuring our school continues to be safe by not sending any nut products to the school. Thank you in advance for your commitment to our safety!

<u>Pick-Up/Drop-Off Safety Reminder:</u>

The bus lane in front of the school is reserved for buses and maintenance vehicles from 8:00 am until 4:00 pm daily. Please do not enter the bus lane during this time.

The main through lane in the parking lot is a <u>DROP and GO</u> lane. Parents are expected to remain in their vehicles. Your child will walk from your car to the school with the assistance of staff in safety vests. Vehicles in the bus lane and unattended cars in the drop-and-go block flow and create hazards to the safety of our students.

Please park in the guest parking area or the overflow lot if you wish to walk your child to their door or to the main entrance. Additionally, please note there are three reserved parking stalls in the staff lot. Please do not park in these stalls at any time throughout the day. Students will be dismissed from their homerooms and exit through their designated doors at 3:05 p.m.

- Parents/Guardians picking up students at school will be asked to wait outside the school.
- We would appreciate your assistance to ensure that all of our Brookwood students are safe and accounted for at the end of the school day. Here's how you can help:
 - Please ensure that your children meet you and stay with you at the end of the school day.
 - Please do not allow your children to play on the playground & swings prior to Bus Dismissal at 3:15.

NUMERACY CORNER

Did you know that playing card or board games can improve and strengthen your child's math skills while also creating valuable family bonding time?!

*Each month here, we will share an easy math game for you and your child to play:

"Salute"

Materials Needed:

Deck of cards with face cards taken out 3 people


Objective: To reinforce addition/subtraction or multiplication/division

Instructions:

- 1. Player #1 and Player #2 sit facing one another, with the deck of cards between them. Player #3 sits off to the side so that he/she can see both players' faces.
- 2. Player #1 and #2 each pick up a card, and without looking at it, place it on their foreheads. They can see what each other has, but they do not know which card they are holding.
- 3. Player #3 (who can see both cards) mentally adds the cards together and says the sum (or product) out loud. For example, if Player #1 is holding a 6 and Player #2 is holding a 10, Player #3 says "16."
- 4. Once Player #3 has said the sum out loud, Players #1 and #2 each try to figure out what card he/she is holding. So if the sum is 16, and Player #1 can see that Player #2 is holding a 10, he can perform a mental subtraction equation to figure out what he has (16-10=6). The first player to correctly state which card they are holding keeps both cards. The player with the most cards at the end of the game wins.
