SAFETY AT BROOKWOOD SCHOOLDrop Off & Pick Up Safety Measures:

The bus lane in front of the school is reserved for buses and maintenance vehicles from 8:00 am until 4:00 pm daily. Please do not enter the bus lane during this time.

The main through lane in the parking lot is a **DROP and GO** lane. Parents are expected to remain in their vehicles. Your child will walk from your car to the school with the assistance of staff in safety vests. Vehicles in the bus lane and unattended cars in the drop-and-go block flow and create hazards to the safety of our students.

Please park in the guest parking area or the overflow lot if you wish to walk your child to their door or to the main entrance. Additionally, please note there are three reserved parking stalls in the staff lot. Please do not park in these stalls at any time throughout the day.

Students will be dismissed from their homerooms and exit through their designated doors at 3:05 p.m.

Parents/Guardians picking up students at school will be asked to wait outside the school. We would appreciate your assistance to ensure that all of our Brookwood students are safe and accounted for at the end of the school day. Here's how you can help:

- Please ensure that your children meet you and stay with you at the end of the school day.
- Please do not allow your children to play on the playground & swings prior to Bus Dismissal at 3:15.

As much as we all enjoy pets, we ask that you keep your dog at home or away from the playground and general school population during school hours. For the safety of our students and your pet, distance is key.

Due to allergies and safety, pets cannot be brought inside Brookwood School, so we kindly ask that you please not bring your animals inside the school or on school property at any time. This includes both big and small dogs.

If you do walk your dog to school to meet your children after school, please kindly wait near the north fence by the bus loop entrance or on the east side of the fence near the alleyway. Thank you for your cooperation with this matter!

As the weather changes and fall/winter gear is coming out, please make sure you are clearly marking your child's gear with student names or initials as we have many identical jackets, footwear etc.

PARENTS. VOLUNTEERS AND VISITORS

We are happy to welcome volunteers at Brookwood School this year!

- For safety reasons, **volunteers and visitors are required to check in at the office.** Our office staff are always happy to help you!
- Parents/Guardians who bring items for their children will be requested to leave it in the office, and we will get it to their child.

Volunteers for In Class and Off-Site Field Trips

- Volunteers are required to submit a "Volunteer Registration Form" at least **48 hours** prior to their actual volunteer service.
- Volunteers are required to have a "Criminal Record Check" if they are volunteering for more than **ten** hours per year.
- Volunteers are required to have a "Criminal Record Check" if they are going "off-site" with students.



Some of our students and staff have life-threatening allergies to nuts and nut products. Therefore, our school is "NUT-AWARE".

We are asking for your help and cooperation in ensuring our school continues to be safe by not sending any nut products to the school. Thank you in advance for your commitment to our safety!

Personal mobile devices

Parkland School Division has a new Administrative Procedure regarding Personal Mobile Devices - <u>AP 670: Personal Mobile Devices.</u> This updated procedure is in alignment with the Ministerial Order (014/2024 Standards for the Use of Personal Mobile Devices and Social Media in Schools)

At Brookwood School, we follow the "Limitations on Use" as noted below:

- 1. Students are prohibited from the use of personal mobile devices during instructional time.
- 2. Students in possession of a personal mobile device shall ensure that device(s) are powered off, and stored out of view;

Snack Pouch Recycling



Often families don't realize how much school their child is missing and the impact that has on everyone. They are more behind than you think.

1 DAY MISSED = 2 DAYS BEHIND



19 or more days

Missing just **TWO** days every month can add up to **19** days in a school year. This is the equivalent of missing an ENTIRE MONTH of instructional days.



10 to 18 days

Students who are absent an average of 15 days per year miss **1 YEAR'S WORTH** of school by their graduating year.



9 or fewer absences

Students with good attendance generally achieve higher grades and enjoy school more.
