# **Brookwood School Association Meeting Minutes**

September 12, 2024

- Meeting called to order upon the completion of the School Council meeting
- Approval of Agenda
  - Approved by Melody, Second by Lisa
- Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes
  - Approved by Melody, Second by Brad
- Additions (if applicable)
  - Book Fair Update
- 1. Treasurer Report (Lisa Huffman)
  - o Casino Account: \$15, 573; General Account: \$77, 173
  - Last year, including Hot Lunch, all our income totaled \$99,297
  - Last year, all our expenses (including the additional expenses we approved throughout the year from the Brookwood Admin Wish List) totaled \$102,168
  - This resulted in a year profit of -\$2871.00; Even though we operated at a loss, we still have a healthy bank account

## 2. 2024/2025 Operating Budget

- This year, we are purchasing the 6 swings for the kindergarten side of the playground - this will use up the majority of what is left in our Casino Account, plus a large chunk of the General Account
- Our school is scheduled to have a Casino Fundraiser this November, so our Casino Account will be replenished early 2025; amount depending on how well the casino fundraiser does
- Because we also pay for a large portion of the Grade 4 Ski Trip, we feel that this year we will be more budget-cautious as our operating budget alone is \$25,000 a year, and we want to ensure we have a healthy budget for future expenses
- This year we received a Brookwood Admin Wish list.
  - The first section of it is educational subscriptions. The subscriptions for RAZ Kids, Mathletics and Generation Genius come to a combined total of \$9,100.00
  - ii. The second section is other items that have been covered in other years. Cultural events for plays and shows plus the Grade 4 Ski Trip come to a combined total of \$11,100
  - iii. As a group, we discussed that due to the budget and what we are looking at for expenses this year, if we were going to choose 1 we would choose the Cultural Events and Grade 4 Ski Trip as this gives new opportunities to our students, and allows more kids to attend the ski trip in a more affordable manner vs. reimbursing the school for their already paid for subscriptions
    - note that covering the expenses of the subscriptions has only been approved and agreed upon when we had the extra means to do so; not a guaranteed yearly commitment
- 3. Swings for the Kindergarten/Grade 1 Side of the Playground
  - We got 3 proposals from companies for the 6 swings to be installed on the Kindergarten/Grade 1 side of the playground

- The group as a whole (with the exception of Angele as per a conflict of interest) all voted to use CRS - Canadian Recreation Solutions, local out of Sherwood Park and send the estimate to Serge at PSD to have it approved before we moved forward
- On September 19, Tyneal sent out an email to all of the association members, making a motion to go ahead and pay the deposit of the swing set to CRS, as Serge from PSD approved our selections and gave us the go ahead to proceed
  - i. Melody second the motion via email, others voted in favor to proceed via email
- By placing this vote, and ordering when we did, we have a chance of getting our swing sets delivered by October 18 - in hopes of having them installed and completed for winter (yay!!)

### 4. Hot Lunch Session 1

 The menu options for hot lunch session 1 was approved by Lisa, Tyneal second, and the group was all in favor to proceed; this year we are incorporating Bite to Eat as another option that we are all looking forward too

### 5. Club Moo Session 1

 Will begin October 10 and will be having a cash day as usual; Susan is doing awesome and has her plans all set out for the year

### 6. 2024/2025 Insurance

 Lisa made a motion to approve the payment of the 2024/2025 insurance premiums for our council and association; Melody approved, Tyneal second, and the group was all in favor to proceed to pay this years insurance premiums

### 7. November Casino Fundraiser Nights

- We have our upcoming Casino Night Fundraiser at Century Casino in St. Albert on Thursday, November 28 and Friday, November 29
- We will need 13 volunteers per day, 26 in total
- Last casino fundraiser we had, our casino advisor had her helpers cover over 17 of our 16 shifts due to a lack of volunteers
- If we do not see a significant commitment from Brookwood volunteers, Tyneal will forfeit our dates and allow another organization to take them and we will not be given another set of dates for 3-4 years

#### 8. Fundraisers for the Year

 We talked about doing Art Cards again this fall, the Read-A-Thon in the new year, Calahoo Meats again in June, and discussed the idea of a Spring Fling dance to support the school and community, possibly joining with Woodhaven for a Water Park tickets/night

# 9. Book Fair

- Our October book fair will be taking place during the week of October 21 to 24th, alongside Parent Teacher Interviews.
- We will need roughly 11 volunteers throughout the afternoon and some evenings
- The profits of the Book Fair do not go into our bank account, but rather become rewards towards our Library
